Guided Pathways Regional Coordinators

Purpose:

Guided Pathways Regional Coordinators provide support to the community colleges throughout the state in their implementation of Guided Pathways using an equity and student centered approach by providing just in time support strategies and collaborating with regional partners. There are a total of 18 Regional Coordinator positions that are assigned throughout the state.
