## Where do we go from here- Local

- Strengthen student support (SI, MESA, Success Centers)
- Learning Communities
- Faculty led discussions about conceptual overlap between STEM disciplines (e.g., Krebs Cycle in Biol. and Chem.)
- Role of Curriculum Committee to facilitate interdisciplinary conversations
- Streamline Local Degrees make local decisions about 'options' in TMCs

## Where do we go from here — System:

- Ask FDRGs to evaluate unit count again (excessive?) Math drives many others disciplines. 4 unit versus 3 unit.
- o 3 hrs lab, 3 hrs lec can we have 'discussion sections'
