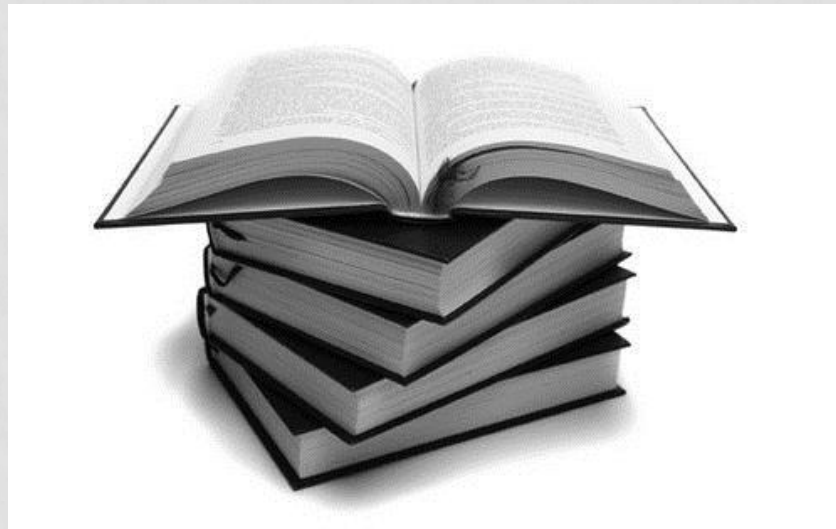

DEGREE APPLICABLE CREDIT COURSE

- Tied to an Associate's Degree
 - Curriculum committee & district governing board approved
 - Units assigned to correspond to lecture and lab hours
 - Prerequisites and corequisites as assigned
 - Course outline of record
 - Can they be repeatable?
 - Impacted by Financial Aid?



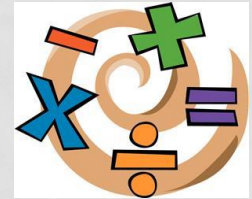


NONCREDIT COURSE

COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFERING

Community Services Education is a program of not-for credit, fee-based classes and activities designed to serve individuals with educational goals that do not require college credit. – Glendale Community College

- Is not approved by the college's curriculum committee or district governing board
- Is not reported to the Curriculum Inventory
- Cannot be claimed for apportionment
- Are not academic equivalents of regular credit classes
- Are not prerequisites for the traditional college program
- Are open to all members of the community
- Repeatable?
- Impacted by financial aid?
